AN ORDINANCE ANNEXING TERRITORY TO THE VILLAGE OF ROSHOLT, WISCONSIN

The Village Board of the Village of Rosholt, Wisconsin do ordain as follows:

Section I - Territory Annexed. In accordance with Section 66.025 of The Wisconsin Statutes of 1967 as amended, the following described territory in the Town of Alban, Portage County, Wisconsin, now solely owned by the Village of Rosholt, Wisconsin, is hereby annexed to the Village of Rosholt, Wisconsin:

Section II - Effective Annexation. From and after the data of this ordinance the territory described in Section I shall be a part of the Village of Rosholt, Wisconsin for any and all purposes provided by law and all persons coming or residing within such territory shall be subject to all ordinances, rules and regulations governing the Village of Rosholt, Wisconsin.

Section III - Severability. If any provision of this ordinance is invalid or unconstitutional, or if the application this ordinance to any person or circumstances is invalid or unconstitutional, such invalidity or unconstitutionality shall not affect the other provisions or applications of this ordinance which can be given effect without the invalid or unconstitutional provision or application.

Section IV - Effective Date -. This ordinance shall take effect upon passage and posting as provided by law.

EXHIBIT "B" The following tract of land in Portage County, State of Wisconsin;

A part of the Southwest Quarter (SW1/4) of the Southeast Quarter (SE1/4) of Section Seventeen in Township Twenty-five (25) North of Range Ten (10) East and commencing at the southwest corner thereof as a point of beginning. Running thence north along the west line thereof a distance of Forty-five (45) rods; thence east at right angle a distance of Twenty (20) Rods; thence south at right angle a distance of Twenty (20 Rods; thence west at right angle a distance of Seventeen (17) Rods; thence south at right angle a distance of twenty-five (25) rods to the south line of said forty; thence west along the south line a distance of three (3) rods to the place of beginning.
