A CHARTER ORDINANCE RELATING TO THE <u>APPOINTMENT OF THE VILLAGE TREASURER</u>

The Village Board of the Village of Rosholt, Wisconsin, do ordain as follows:

Section 1 The Village of Rosholt hereby elects that, pursuant to the provisions of Sec. 66.01 and Sec. 61.197(1) (c) of the Wisconsin Statutes, the method of selection of the incumbent for the office of Village Treasurer shall be as provided in this ordinance.

Section 2 The incumbent for the Village Treasurer position, namely Village Treasurer, shall be appointed by the Village Board of the Village of Rosholt and shall serve for a term of two (2) years. The first appointment for such position shall be held in April 1997 and each two (2) years thereafter, and the person appointed shall take office on May 1 next succeeding their appointment.

Section 3 This is a charter ordinance and shall take effect sixty (60) days after its passage and publication unless within such sixty (60) days a referendum petition as provided in Sec. 66.01 of the Wisconsin Statutes shall be filed, in which event this ordinance shall be subject to a referendum of the electors voting therein.

ORDINANCE

In keeping with the provisions of Section 74.08 of the Wisconsin Statues, the Village Board of the Village of Rosholt, Portage County, Wisconsin, does hereby ordain as follows:

That until changed by ordinance, the Village Treasurer of said Village of Rosholt, shall in the future enter in each receipt given by him for the payment of taxes, the aggregate amount of state, county, local, school and other taxes in a single column.

Be it further ordained that in the future there shall be printed or stamped on such tax receipts the separate proportion or rate of taxes levied for state, county, county school tax levied pursuant to Section 59.07 (21)(a) of the Wisconsin Statutes, local school and other purposes.

IT IS FURTHER ORDAINED that ordinance shall supersede all other provisions of law in conflict therewith.

This ordinance shall be posted in three (3) public places in the Village of Rosholt and shall be effective the day after proof of posting has been filed and recorded with the Village Clerk as provided by law.
